

MASKS

In plays like the Ram Lila, which tells the story of Rama and Sita, some actors wear beautiful painted masks made of cardboard or papier mâché. On this sheet there is an outline picture of a mask for the demon king of Lanka, Ravana, and on the next sheet, a mask for Hanuman, the monkey god.

MASK OF RAVANA

- 1 Paint the mask with bright colours, making it look as lifelike as possible.
- 2 Carefully cut out the mask and make holes for the eyes and nose.
- 3 Fasten string or elastic to the sides, and it is ready to wear.
